Rebecca "Becca" Christine Chappell, 19, lost her battle with acute myeloid leukemia Tuesday morning, Jan. 22, 2008. She died at home in the loving embrace of her family.



Becca was born on Aug. 5, 1988, in Columbia, S.C. She attended Lonnie B. Nelson Elementary and Dent Middle Schools, graduating in 2006 from Richland Northeast High School. There she participated as a member of the Cavalier Chorale, the varsity girls' tennis team, and the junior varsity girls' soccer team. She served as a captain of the tennis team in her junior and senior years. Until her illness

required her to withdraw, Becca was a student in the University of South Carolina College of Nursing.

Rebecca will be remembered for her intelligence, sense of humor, loyalty to friends and family, and common sense that belied her years. She cherished her independence, and fought bravely to maintain it in the face of her illness.

Becca is survived by her parents, Henry W. Chappell, Jr. and Kathleen D. Chappell of Columbia; her brother, Timothy B. Chappell of Columbia; her maternal grandparents, Richard J. Dietz and Mary J. Dietz of Virginia Beach, VA; her paternal grandfather, Henry W. Chappell, and step-grandmother, Jane A. Chappell of Williamsburg, VA; and many loving aunts, uncles and cousins. She was preceded in death by her paternal grandmother, Alice B. Chappell.

The family wishes to acknowledge the loving care given to Becca during the past 14 months by the doctors, nurses and staff of the Children's Cancer and Blood Disorder Clinic at Palmetto Health Richland.
